As you are aware, the Postal Service was excluded from receiving any financial assistance in the last stimulus package. Without assistance from the federal government, the Postal Service will run out of funds by June 2020.

I need your help. Please log on to NALC.Org. Click on to "News and Information." Scroll down to "Action Needed." On the bottom right hand of the page, all you must do is type in the following: First Initial + Last Name + Your Zip Code. Once done, your Senators and Congressperson's name will appear on the screen. A form letter has already been constructed. Fill in your name and county, then press "GO." It's that simple.

These are desperate times for Letter Carriers. I ask you to encourage everyone you know to write to our federal legislators for help. Do whatever you can to help "Save Our Postal Service." Please share this information with co-workers, while keeping in mind Hatch Act regulations. Your cooperation has never been more critical.
